FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL PHOTOS

Have teachers help you collect these images from parents. The first day of school pictures might look different than our normal first day of school pictures, but these will be extra fun to look back on!



STUDENT SPOTLIGHTS

Highlight each student at your school. Feature 4-6 students on a page with a fun virtual learning photo and quote from the student. Questions that can be asked to the student include:
What do you like the most about virtual learning?
What do you dislike about virtual learning?
What do you miss most about school?

Tackle 10 students a week or ask teachers and parents for help collecting this information.



WHEN I GROW UP PHOTOS

Work with your school community on setting up a fun school-wide activity day where everyone dresses up like what they want to be when they grow up. These fun pictures can also be used to create your class pages.

DISPLAY ARTWORK MADE AT HOME

Fun art projects can also be included in your yearbook. Collect digital images of these projects and include some on each page of your yearbook.



VIRTUAL CLASS PARTIES & SCHOOL SPIRIT DAYS AT HOME

Just because you're not all in one building together doesn't mean the fun has to stop! Collect images from teachers and parents showing how they are still celebrating fun days with their classmates virtually.
